On the nose, that takes the form of a rainy cement note, which, along with lime-skin and pith scents, give fresh tension to the broad peach and pear aromas. It is famous for two things, oysters and this wine of origin Picpoul. With bright, zippy acidity, a hint of effervescence and flavors of lime, lemon zest and an inherent salinity, this is the perfect wine to beat the heat or to pair with oysters! Picpoul is an ancient grape whose name translates literally as "stings the lip", a reference to the grape's ability to keep its' mouthwatering high acidity even when grown in a hot, Mediterranean climate.</i>		
DOMAINE MICHEL BRÉGEON, 2015 MUSCADET SEVRE ET MAINE SUR LIE, LOIRE VALLEY, FRANCE	11 	42
<i>100% MELON DE BOURGOGNE. Bone dry, flinty, mouthwatering acidity. Fresh as the tanginess of an ocean breeze, the beautifully-made 2015 Domaine Michel Brégeon Muscadet Sèvre et Maine Sur Lie exhibits aromas and flavors of mineral and chalk. The wine's dried citrus notes and very crisp finish invite a plate of a dozen or more raw oysters as an accompaniment. - 91 pts., Wilfred Wong-Wine.com</i>

<i>100% SAUVIGNON BLANC. This wine indulges the nose with grapefruit, tropical aromas of passion fruit, ripe red capsicum with hints of cumin seeds. The palate is smooth, full, ripe and rich; fruit driven with firm, lively acidity & a fine structure. Pairs perfectly with seafood and acidic salads.</i>		
TWOMEY CELLARS BY SILVER OAK, 2018 SAUVIGNON BLANC, SONOMA COUNTY, CALIFORNIA		52
<i>100% SAUVIGNON BLANC. This is the ONLY white wine Silver Oak produces, a request of the lady of the house to produce a quality "porch pounder!" It has a light straw yellow color and an enticing nose of kaffir lime, pear, elderberry, crystalized ginger and wet slate. The full palate is highlighted by a sweet attack which is deftly balanced by fresh, vibrant acidity and a purity of fruit. This layered, complex, well-knit wine has an extremely long finish with echoes of citrus, stone fruit and nice minerality.</i>

<i>50% VIOGNIER, 50% SAUVIGNON BLANC. An unconventional blend that combines the freshness and acidity of Sauvignon Blanc with the flesh and depth of Viognier coming together to make an aromatic wine perfect for warm summer nights. Light yellow in appearance with green hues, it boasts alluring aromas of grapefruit, apricot, boxwood and mango, with tropical flavors on the palate. Refreshing acidity and structure grace the palate and follow through to a remarkable finish.</i>

- KUENTZ-BAS, 2017 ALSACE BLANC, ALSACE, FRANCE** 37
 60% SYLVANER, 20% AUXERROIS, 20% MUSCAT. *This beguiling mélange of Sylvaner, Muscat and Auxerrois with its gorgeous, green-gold color to its heady, floral aromas of muskmelon, jasmine, gardenia blossoms, tangerine and cinnamon, delivers classic Alsatian character and terroir. The palate is dry and bracing with notes of quince, honey, dried orange peel and herbs, yielding to a long, clean, crisp finish. A terrific anytime, anyplace sipper or a lovely with redfish, salmon, pork or poultry.*
- WILLIAM FEVRE, 2017 CHABLIS - CHAMPS ROYAUX, BURGUNDY, FRANCE** 12  46
 100% CHARDONNAY. *An impressively precise Chablis, delivering a nose of citrus fruits, flowers, green apple and flinty flavors of wet stone in the mid-palate with a beautifully clean finish. Fresh, supple, it is marked by mineral notes, typical of the appellation. A perfect accompaniment for grilled fish & oysters but would also work well with chicken with fresh herbs.*
- JOSEPH DROUHIN, 2016 LAFORÊT - BOURGOGNE BLANC, BURGUNDY, FRANCE** 9 34
 100% CHARDONNAY. *An excellent, entry level Burgundy made with grapes from all over Burgundy from vineyards high up at the top of the slopes, close to the forest or "LaForêt". Aged in stainless steel vats 7 to 8 months, with part of the wine aged in oak barrels, allowing the gentle marriage with oxygen, resulting in a wine that is not overly woody but rich in aromas.*
- NEW VINCENT GIRARDIN, 2015 CUVÉE SAINT VINCENT, BOURGOGNE BLANC, BURGUNDY, FRANCE** 48
 100% CHARDONNAY. *A floral and fruity wine (citrus, peach) with mineral notes and a beautiful length. A good pairing wine for plenty of dishes. Pair with seafood, grilled fish, white meat and cheese. The grapes come from parcels located in the regional area production of Meursault and Chassagne-Montrachet.*
- DOMAINE DE LA CHAPELLE, 2016 POUILLY-FUISSÉ VIEILLES VIGNES, BURGUNDY, FRANCE** 60
 100% CHARDONNAY. *This pale gold, old vines cuvée, shows sweetness on the nose, is full-bodied with ripe, open fruit and an elegant finish; just right on the Goldilocks test. Pouilly-Fuissé is from southern Burgundy's Mâconnais district. **8 gold medals, 3 Silver medals in 17 years.***
- FRANK FAMILY VINEYARDS, 2017 CARNEROS CHARDONNAY, NAPA VALLEY, CALIFORNIA** 61
 100% CHARDONNAY. *Pale yellow straw color with aromas of white flowers, stone fruit, lemon zest & a hint of vanilla, leading to a rich, enveloping palate of lychee fruit and toasted almonds with bright, nice acidity. Barrel fermented in French oak for 9 months.*
- HAHN FAMILY, 2017 S-L-H CHARDONNAY, SANTA LUCIA HIGHLANDS, CALIFORNIA** 11  42
 100% CHARDONNAY. *Crisp aromas of white peach, honeysuckle & vanilla with hints of citrus and banana. Salt and nectarine appear strongly on the palate... Full bodied with viscous, round mouth-feel; citrus balances waves of caramel on the acidic finish. - **90 pts., Wine Enthusiast***
- NEW DOMAINE BENOIT GAUTIER, 2017 VOUVRAY DE GAUTIER, LOIRE VALLEY, FRANCE** 11 42
 100% CHENIN BLANC. *Benoit Gautier's signature wine made from a selection of ripe Chenin Blanc grapes from his best vineyards. Grapes are pressed in a pneumatic press at low temperature and fermented with the natural yeasts from the grape skins. The wine matures on its fine lees in temperature-controlled stainless-steel tanks over four months with no malolactic fermentation. The fruity acidity of the Chenin Blanc is balanced with apricot, pear and honey notes and just enough residual sugar to attain a slightly off-dry finish. "Juicy and pure, with a tasty mix of green and yellow apple fruit intertwined with fennel, anise and star fruit notes. Offers a bright, juicy finish" - **90 pts. Wine Spectator***
- DR. HERMANN, 2018 RIESLING, MOSEL, GERMANY** 10 38
 100% RIESLING. *Light yellow-green color with notes of herbs and stone fruits, Meyer lemon and hints of saffron and ginger. Sweet, fresh, fruity on the palate with peach, tangerine, apple with lively acidity, finishing crisp, focused & clean. Great on its' own or with seafood and spicy foods.*
- MARCHESI INCISA DELLA ROCCHETTA, 2018 FELICE, MOSCATO D'ASTI D.O.C.G., PIEDMONT, ITALY** 10  38
 100% MOSCATO. *Pale straw yellow in color. Heady perfume of fresh vine flower, peach and tropical fruits. Gently sweet with restrained alcohol, the vibrant fruit flavors envelop the palate, underscored by a refreshing acidity. Pairs well with fruit, sweet cheeses; mascarpone, and sweet desserts; fresh berries and cream, pineapple, pastries and white chocolate or enjoy alone as a sweet aperitivo.*

- TUCK BECKSTOFFER, 2017 HOGWASH ROSÉ, CENTRAL COAST, CALIFORNIA** 11  42
 100% GRENACHE. *Hogwash Rosé is pure fun, a real twist-the-top-and-throw-in-some-ice-cubes- cause-you-can't-wait-for-it-to-chill barefoot, barbecue, poolside, beachside, lakeside, in the park, summertime sit on FRANK'S porch wine! The nose is a perfect marriage of red berry & ripe melon. Bone dry on the palate, the minerality intermingles beautifully with flavors of lime curd, orange rind, d'Anjou pear & rose hips. Perfect for casual summer sipping, paired with a plate of pork hot off the grill; which is, of course, how it got its name.*
- MAISON NOIR, 2017 LOVE DRUNK ROSÉ, WILLAMETTE VALLEY, OREGON** 10  38
 85% CHARDONNAY, 15% PINOT NOIR. *From former French Laundry Sommelier, André Mack. He says it clouds the brain, causes eyes to sparkle, cheeks to glow, blood pressure to rise and lips to pucker. Aromas of strawberry and raspberry, followed by refreshing flavors of wild strawberry, watermelon rind and a hint of kiwi. 100% single vineyard fruit, from the oldest and best vines make it special. 100 Barrels Made!*
- CHÂTEAU DE TRINQUEVEDEL, 2017 TAVEL A.O.C., ROSÉ, RHÔNE VALLEY, FRANCE** 45
 45% GRENACHE, 24% CINSULT, 15% CLAIRETTE, 10% MOURVÈDRE, 6% SYRAH. *Tavel is the only A.O.C. in all of France made up entirely of rosé. These darker-hued rosés contain a maximum of 60 percent Grenache and are chock full of flavor. Made by the direct press method from 30-plus-year-old vines. Full of ripe raspberry flavors speckled with notes of "garrigue," this is about as terroir-driven as it gets.*

- GÖNC 1936, 2018 CUVÉE ANNA ROSÉ, PREKMURJE, SLOVENIA** 11 42
 50% ŽAMETNA ČRNINA, 20% PINOT NOIR, 20% PINOT GRIGIO, 10% BLAUFRANKISCH. *I love this newly-landed rosé from Slovenia! Named after the winemaker's grandmother, Cuvée Anna is ripe with aromas of wild berries, strawberries, melons and peaches. On the palate, it's bright and fruity with a lively, refreshing finish. I had it on a recent warm day with some grilled chicken and a goat cheese salad and it was perfect. **Fun fact:** Žametna črnina is the oldest-known grape varietal in the world, 375-400 years old and is traditionally planted in Slovenia.*
- LA PERDRIX, 2018 ROSÉ, COSTIÈRES DE NÎMES A.O.P., RHÔNE VALLEY, FRANCE** 10 38
 60% GRENACHE, 40% SYRAH. *"La Perdrix" dates back to the 13th century, when King Louis IX (Saint Louis) of France, hunted partridge (perdrix) on the estate's grounds. Pale pink color with a fuchsia hue and a complex nose with aromas of wild strawberry, cherry, and raspberry. The palate is generous and harmonious, enlivened by ripe and persistent notes of raspberry. Enjoy with any summer meal or by itself.*
- DOMAINE GUENEAU, 2018 SANCERRE ROSÉ, RHÔNE VALLEY, FRANCE** 49
 100% PINOT NOIR. *This wine offers aromas of pear, apple, and red berries. On the palate, it is very soft and round, with a good minerality and aromas of wild red fruits and nice sweet notes. Superb by itself or with lighter summer fare.*
- CHÂTEAU DES ANNIBALS, 2018 CUVÉE SUIVEZ-MOI-JEUNE-HOMME ROSÉ, PROVENCE, FRANCE** 49
 40% GRENACHE, 30% SYRAH, 20% CINSULT, 10% ROLLE. *Elegant salmon pink color. Complexity and powerful aromas of raspberry, lime, candy, slightly minty notes, give a very generous bouquet. On the palate, this wine is rich, with notes evolving towards strawberries and blueberries with a smooth minerality, adding freshness, and a long finish with persisting notes of red fruit. A superb Rosé!*

SEAN MINOR, 2017 FOUR BEARS PINOT NOIR, CENTRAL COAST, CALIFORNIA	9	34
<i>100% PINOT NOIR. A medium bodied Pinot Noir that displays aromas of ripe plum, violets & cocoa. On the palate it offers luscious flavors of dark cherry, blackberry & floral notes with a touch of spice. The bright acidity makes this a great food wine. A LOT of bang for the buck.</i>		
ERATH, 2017 RESPLENDENT PINOT NOIR, DUNDEE HILLS, OREGON	12	46
<i>100% PINOT NOIR. Erath is the oldest winery in the Dundee Hills of Oregon. This is a lovely, seductive, well balanced Oregon Pinot Noir. Ruby, bright color with aromas of fleshy cherry with medium fruit, acidity & tannins. It's fruit forward with red berry, moderate baking spice, a hint of tart pomegranate and spice on the finish. Superb with roasted chicken & pork. Easily drinkable on its own, a great social after-work sipper. Yummy!</i>		
SCHUG, 2017 CARNEROS PINOT NOIR, SONOMA COUNTY, CALIFORNIA		62
<i>100% PINOT NOIR. A complex wine with a rich bouquet of cherries, berries and hints of spicy new oak. It has flavors of black cherry, currant, and strawberry, followed by a rich, spicy texture and a long silky finish. Pairs nicely with lamb, duck, even grilled fish. - 92 pts., James Suckling</i>		
NEW STEPHEN ROSS, 2016 PINOT NOIR, SANTA LUCIA HIGHLANDS, CALIFORNIA	15	55
<i>100% PINOT NOIR. Dense ruby color. Raspberry and rose petal aromas with savory note of thyme and a touch of nutmeg/vanilla. Exquisite balance, flavors of small red berries and firm tannins on the finish. Burgundian winemaking techniques were used in making this wine; cold soak for several days, punched down in open top tanks, pressed with a state-of-the-art stainless-steel basket press and aged in Burgundian barrels.</i>		
NEW STEPHEN ROSS, 2013 CHORRO CREEK VINEYARD PINOT NOIR, SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY, CALIFORNIA		84
<i>100% PINOT NOIR. Medium ruby color; bright, earthy aromas of cherry, boysenberry and light cola with an herbal side of charred pine, alongside licorice and dried strawberries. The palate is focused, with flavors of cherry and red raspberry with pomegranate and tea accents; good structure and balance; long finish. A focused and lively Pinot with terrific flavors. - 92 pts., Wine Enthusiast, - 90 pts., PinotReport</i>		
BELLE GLOS, 2017 DAIRYMAN PINOT NOIR, RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY, SONOMA COUNTY, CALIFORNIA		62
<i>100% PINOT NOIR. Bright crimson red color with aromas of black cherry and ripe plums with notes of dried herbs and smoke. The palate shows flavors of cranberry, fresh raspberry and ripe cherry, hints of vanilla and baking spice. A balance of savory, cedar, cocoa powder, fig jam and ripe blackberry round out the mouth-feel. Great structure, smooth tannins and a lingering fresh finish. Once a dairy farm, now a Pinot Noir vineyard!</i>		
NEW KAIKEN, 2015 MALBEC ULTRA, MENDOZA, ARGENTINA	12	46
<i>100% MALBEC. Deep ruby color with violet hues. Flowery nose, mineral notes are evident and spicy touches make the wine more complex; finely blended with the elegance of the French oak. A wine of great structure and power - sweet plum, mocha and black cherry flavors blend with well-integrated oak and tannins, both soft and present. KENWOOD VINEYARDS, 2014 MERLOT, SONOMA COUNTY, CALIFORNIA	9	34
<i>100% MERLOT. Fruity aromas of ripe plum and dried cherry combine with spicy notes of cinnamon, licorice and vanilla to give this Merlot a complex character. Well-balanced tannins and velvety mouthfeel lead to a long finish.</i>

<i>100% CABERNET SAUVIGNON. Showcasing fruit from Lake and Mendocino Counties, rich and balanced with aromas of red currents, strawberry jam and black berries and a touch of fresh hay. On the palate, the juicy, bright fruit flavors are framed by rich, refined tannin, nice finish.</i>		
LUKE, 2016 CABERNET SAUVIGNON, WAHLUKE SLOPE A.V.A., COLUMBIA VALLEY, WASHINGTON		57
<i>77% CABERNET SAUVIGNON, 9% MERLOT, 7% MALBEC, 6% PETIT VERDOT, 1% CABERNET FRANC. This beauty offers aromas dominated by Marionberry and dark chocolate, accented by hints of mint and molasses. Pierre Ferrand cognacs are distilled slowly, in small pot stills then aged on the original wine's unfiltered lees. Particularly rich in fruit aromas, the lees help to give the raw spirit body and flavor, elements that will mature as they are aged in small oak barrels. After years of aging, cellar masters practice the subtle and precise art of blending, passed on through five generations to create an incomparable cognac.
